SELECTIONS FOR NATIONAL YOUTH TEAM (NYT) 2019

This notice is to inform you on the following selection procedure for NYT 2019.

- 2 Selection to NYT will be based on scores attained (during the period 1 May 2018 to 31 April 2019) from these competitions:
 - a. Local SSA Sanctioned Competitions
 - b. National Inter-School Championships
 - c. SSA Recognized Overseas Competitions

Shooters who have taken official leave from NYT will be given a separate consideration on a case-by-case basis.

Please note that meeting the MQS does not guarantee a place in the team. The Final decision will be made by the High Performance Dept and the Coaches

Those who meet the 3 scores will be shortlisted first. Thereafter, shooters will be ranked by 3 highest average. If there is a tie, highest score will be used to break the tie.

Shooters who met the mark but are ranked 7th position and below will be asked to participate in a 3-mth trial.

Past NYT Shooters will need to meet the NYT Retaining Score in order to be considered for re-entry to NYT.
