GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Date & Facilities

1.1 The competition will be held from 9th and 16th June 2024 at:

***SAFRA Yishun Indoor Air Weapons Range
60 Yishun Avenue 4 Singapore 769027***

1.2 Sius Ascor Electronic Targets system will be used for this event.

2. General Rules

2.1 The Pistol and Rifle events will be conducted according to the rules and regulations of the International Shooting Sports Federation (ISSF), Edition 2022.

2.2 Governed by the SYOF General Rules and Regulations.

2.3 Additional Competition Rules

10m events.

- a. An Athlete shall only change his/her air cylinder at the firing point only after he/she has ensured that his/her air gun is cleared and inserted a safety line in his/her air gun.
- b. A coach or manager shall personally hand an item to an athlete who is in the field of play only after obtaining the approval of the Range Officer. The athlete must ensure that the air gun is cleared and inserted with a safety line. It is prohibited to engage the help of the Range Officer to pass over any item among athletes, coaches, and managers during the competition.

- c. The Range Officer shall assist an athlete to unload an air gun at the firing point with the use of a pellet discharge cylinder during the competition only upon the request of the Athlete.
- d. An athlete who leaves his/her air gun unattended or fails to handle his/her air gun safely shall be disqualified immediately.
- e. An Athlete who does not promptly remove the air gun from the firing point after the **Range Clear** command shall be warned and/or disqualified.

3. Eligibility

3.1 All participants must be a Singapore Citizen OR Permanent Resident age between 11 to 14 years old.

Youth 12 (Y12) born 1st Jan 2012 to 31st Dec 2013
Youth 14 (Y14) born 1st Jan 2010 to 31st Dec 2011

- . 6.2 The maximum number of participants per event is 30. All participating schools/clubs* are entitled to entrance of their first athlete. Subsequent inclusions will be subject to availability of firing point.
- . 6.3 Participating schools/clubs* are requested to submit their athletes' names in priority from 1 to 3. Participants' parents must give their consent by signing the consent form.
- . 6.4 Entries will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis.
- . 6.5 Registration Fee: \$30.00 per athlete.

- . 6.7 Registration deadline closes on **31st May 2024, 12pm.**

7. Reporting

7.1 Participant(s) must bring along and produce his/her.

- . 7.1.1 Valid Singapore pink identity card or
- . 7.1.2 Valid Singapore passport, student pass with NRIC number.
- . 7.1.3 A completed copy of the parent consent form.

- . 7.1.4 Failure to produce identification document & parent consent form will result in disqualification, the registration fee will apply.
- . 7.1.5 In the case of no show, the registration fee will apply.
- 7.2 All participants must register with the competition officials at least 45 minutes prior to their scheduled match time, at small range A.

8. EQUIPMENT CONTROL

- . 8.1 Trigger checks will be conducted for all pistol events 45 minutes prior to the competition start-time in the small range A.
- . 8.2 All other equipment control checks will be done at random by the appointed jury members.

9. OFFICIAL & Pre-Event Training (PET)

- . 9.1 There will be NO official & Pre-Event Training (PET).
- . 9.2 Dry firing area is limited to small range A for all participants.

10. Sports Equipment

- . 10.1 All participants must provide their own gun(s), equipment(s) and ammunition(s).

11. Medals & Award Ceremony

- . 11.1 Medals will be awarded to the Top 4 Individuals for each of the 8 events.
- . 11.2 The award ceremony will take place at the end of each day.
