

1 INTRODUCTION

1.1 The Singapore Shooting Association ("SSA") is pleased to invite Ministry of Education ("MOE")'s Schools, Polytechnics, Universities and Constituent Members of the SSA to participate in the Singapore Cup Series 2024. There will be a total of 11 Singapore Cup events in 2024. This General Information ("GI") covers only the Pistol and Rifle events as presented in Schedule A. Please note that the event dates are subject to changes, depending on range availability. Participants are advised to check SSA website (www.singaporeshooting.org) for update.

2 COMPETITION VENUES

2.1 10m events:

SAFRA Yishun Indoor Air Weapon Range ("IAWR") located at 60 Yishun Avenue 4, #01-05, SAFRA Yishun Country Club Singapore 769027. The IAWR has a total of thirty-three shooting bays equipped with Sius Ascor electronic target system.

2.2 25m & 50m events:

National Shooting Centre ("NSC") located at 990 Old Choa Chu Kang Road Singapore 699814. The NSC has a total of 15 shooting bays in 50m range and 6 groups of targets in 25m range, both ranges are equipped with Sius Ascor electronic target system.

3 EVENTS & FINALS

3.1 The events listed below are offered in SG CUP 2024

^{*}Combined: Men & women will compete in the same event & finals, similar to 50m 3 position event.



- 3.2 The eight top-scoring participants ("Finalists") shall enter the Finals. A finalist must compete in the Finals, failing which his/her qualification scores shall be declared null and void unless permitted.
- 3.3 Medals will be awarded to top 3 athletes representing school or club for the following 4 events and category only:
 - a. 10m Air Rifle Men MQS
 - b. 10m Air Rifle Women MQS
 - c. 10m Air Pistol Men MQS
 - d. 10m Air Pistol Women MQS
- 3.4 There are no Finals for MQS.

4 SCORES & RANKING

4.1 The SG CUP competition scores shall be taken into consideration for National Ranking and SSA selections. Results will be uploaded to the SSA website at the end of that SG CUP.

5 ELIGIBILITY & REQUIREMENTS

5.1 10m events:

Participant **must** fulfil one of the two conditions:

- He/She must be a member of one of the constituent member club ** of the SSA; OR
- b. He/She must be a current student of an MOE School / Polytechnic / University
- 5.2 25m and 50m events:

Participant **must** fulfil one of the two conditions:

a. He/She must be a member of one of the constituent members ** of the SSA, and must have a gun permit or class license issued by the Police Licensing and Regulatory Department, OR



b. He/She must be a current student of an MOE School / Polytechnic / University, and must have a gun permit or class license issued by the Police Licensing and Regulatory Department

In addition, a participant **must** fulfil a one-off assessment program for the event he/she is participating and submit the scores to the SSA for endorsement through his/her club at least **5 workdays** before the registration closes for consideration:

Modified MQS – these programs shall be conducted by the respective club (s)

Event	Program	Time	Hitting MQS Criteria
25m Pistol Women and 25m Pistol Men Junior		30 minutes	Hit a minimum of 6 points for every shot.
25m Standard Pistol	30 competition shots (1 series of 150 secs, 20 secs and 10 secs)	30 minutes	Hit a minimum of 6 points for every shot.
50m Rifle 3 Position	60 competition shots (20 kneeling, 20 prone and 20 standing***)	100 minutes	Hit a minimum of 5 points for every shot.

^{***} Athletes who already attained a score of 500> in 10m AR events can be exempted from the standing position

6 ONLINE REGISTRATION RULES & RESTRICTIONS

- 6.1 Registration must be duly completed online using the registration link by the deadline stipulated in schedule A. Upon successful registration, you will receive a Registration Acknowledgement. All shortlisted participants will receive further instructions regarding payment. Withdrawal, substitution to any registration after the deadline will not be accepted. Unpaid registrations will be recorded and denied from future SSA events until payments are cleared and to the satisfaction of SSA.
- 6.2 The maximum participants per event are stated in the table below.

6.4 All successful registrants ("Confirmed Participants") for the SG CUP will be notified via email.

6.5 Registration Restriction – **DOES NOT APPLY TO NATIONAL / NATIONAL YOUTH TEAM**

The maximum participants per event are **30** for 10m events, **12** for 50m event, **15** for 25m event. Each participating school/club may register up to a maximum of **3** entries per event in priority sequence via the google registration form. Subsequent entries will be counted as "Reserves" and may only be included if there are available firing points on a first come first served basis and at the discretion of SSA.

7 REPORTING AT VENUE

7.1 All Confirmed Participants are required to report to the shooting venue at least 45 minutes before the start of the event.

8. FEES & PAYMENT

8.1 Registration fee: SGD 26 per participant per eventLate registration (subject to availability) and amendment fee: Additional SGD 13.00



9 GENERAL RULES

9.1 All events will be conducted according to the International Shooting Sports

Federation (ISSF) Rules and Regulations, EDITION 2022 (First Print 01/2023)

Effective 1 January 2022.

10 ADDITIONAL COMPETITION RULES

10.1 10m events.

- a. An Athlete shall only change his/her air cylinder at the firing point only after he/she has ensured that his/her air gun is cleared and inserted a safety line in his/her air gun.
- b. A coach or manager shall personally hand an item to an Athlete who is in the field of play only after obtaining the approval of the Range Officer. The Athlete must ensure that the air gun is cleared and inserted with a safety line. It is prohibited to engage the help of the Range Officer to pass over any item among athletes, coaches, and managers during the competition.
- c. The Range Officer shall assist an Athlete to unload an air gun at the firing point with the use of a pellet discharge cylinder during the competition only upon the request of the Athlete.
- d. An Athlete who leaves his/her air gun unattended or fails to handle his/her air gun safely shall be disqualified immediately.
- e. An Athlete who does not promptly remove the air gun from the firing point after the **Range Clear** command shall be warned and/or disgualified.



10.2 <u>25m and 50m events</u>

a. All other prevailing NSC rules apply.

11 EQUIPMENT CONTROL

11.1 Random trigger check shall be conducted for <u>10m</u> pistol events immediately after the competition.

12 GUNS AND EQUIPMENT

12.1 All Confirmed Participants are to <u>prepare their own guns, ammunitions and</u>
<u>equipment</u> including transportation, storage, and security clearance. They are fully responsible for their guns, ammunition, and equipment at all times.

13 SAFETY AND EXPECTED ORDER

- 13.1 All Confirmed Participants must comply with the safety requirements as per ISSF Rulebook (General Safety Rule; 6.2.1 & Gun Handling Rule; 6.2.2). Failure to do so shall result in immediate disqualification.
- 13.2 All Confirmed Participants, their coaches/managers and spectators are expected to behave orderly at the range and treat the athletes and officials with respect. Anyone who is deemed to have behaved or to be behaving improperly, inappropriately, aggressively, disrespectfully, or dangerously shall be asked to leave the range or may be removed from the range by the security at the discretion of the SSA.
