The Services shall be supplied and delivered in accordance with the requirements set out in the Invitation to Tender, including the Instructions to Tenderers (Part 1), the Conditions of Contract (Part 2), the Requirement Specifications (Part 3) and any other documents of the Invitation to Tender.
 3. Our Offer is fully consistent with and does not contradict or derogate from anything in Part 1 and 2 of your Invitation to Tender. We have not qualified or changed any of the provisions in Part 1 and 2 of your Invitation to Tender. If our Offer is inconsistent with, contradicts or derogates from anything in Part 1 and 2 of your Invitation to Tender, you are entitled to treat our Offer as if it did not include any such inconsistency, contradiction or derogation with Part 1 and 2 of your Invitation to Tender, and your acceptance of our Offer will be construed accordingly. Without prejudice to the aforesaid, we may include in our Offer, alternative offer(s) for the supply of the Services, which will not have an adverse effect on the quality or performance of the Services as set out in Part 3 of your Invitation to Tender.

- a) Our Offer is valid and remains open for acceptance by you for ninety (90) days from the Closing Date (herein referred to as "**Validity Period**") of this Tender. We agree to any subsequent extension of the Validity Period.
- b) For the duration of the Validity Period, we shall be bound by the prices offered as set out or referred to in the Price Schedule of the Invitation to Tender.
4. Our price (herein referred to as "**Contract Price**") for the Services to be supplied by us is SGD_____.
5. A breakdown of the Contract Price for the Services is given in the Price Schedule attached hereto.
6. At your absolute discretion, you may reject any or all offers. We understand that you are not bound to accept the lowest or any offer or assign any reason for the rejection of any offer. At your option, you shall be entitled to accept our Offer in part or as a whole.
7. This is to confirm that we and all of our directors **have / have not** (Delete as appropriate) been debarred from participating in any Government/Statutory Board tenders.

When required by you, we shall execute a formal agreement in or substantially in the form set out in Supplement to the Conditions of Contract together with such further terms and conditions, if any, agreed upon between you and us. Until the formal agreement is executed, this Offer together with your written acceptance thereof and the Covering Letter, Instructions to Tenderers (Part 1), Conditions of Contract (Part 2), Requirement Specifications (Part 3), Price Schedule and other documents (if any) of the Invitation to Tender shall constitute a binding agreement between us.

In addition, when required by you, within fourteen (14) days from the date of issue of your Letter of Acceptance to us, we will lodge a security deposit with you in the form of a performance bond/banker's guarantee, strictly in compliance with the Contract, issued by a bank or insurance company registered with the Monetary Authority of Singapore ("**MAS**"), or issued by a licensed finance company registered with the MAS if the Security Deposit does not exceed SGD300,000.

 - c. Declaration of GST (in the form set out in Annex C of Part 5);

 - e. Power of Attorney – if Tenderer is acting on behalf of a principal – see Clause 38.1 of the Instructions to Tenderers (Part 1); and
